

Chapel Policy

Champion Christian College exists to develop students educationally, socially and spiritually. These important objectives are not only accomplished through classroom instruction, but also through other activities outside of the classroom. Chapel is a key component in the development of a Champion student. It nurtures spiritual refreshment and campus unity. For this reason, chapel attendance is imperative. Chapel meets at 10:00 AM on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. These are the guidelines regarding student attendance to chapel:

1. Students are expected to attend chapel each day in which they attend classes.
2. Students who do not have classes on chapel days are encouraged to attend at least one chapel service each week.
3. In order to be considered present for chapel, each student must sign in for chapel. Students may only sign in for themselves; **No one may sign in to chapel by proxy.**
4. If students received an excused absence from all classes, they are excused from chapel for that day as well. If students attend any class on a chapel day, but will miss chapel, they should contact the dean of men or women prior to their absence to secure an excused absence from chapel. The college administration will determine if a student's absence is considered excused or not.
5. Students are expected to be on time for chapel. Two times of being tardy to chapel are treated as one unexcused absence. Students who are more than 15 minutes late for chapel are considered absent.
6. Any unexcused absence will begin discipline proceedings which may include warnings, meeting with discipline personnel, fines and/or work detail. Habitual absences may result in suspension.
