RE: Accreditation, Category II for Champion Christian College

Dear Dr. Capaci:

At its meeting on November 5, 2019, the TRACS Accreditation Commission voted to grant Champion Christian College (CCC) Accreditation status as a Category II institution approved to offer the following degree programs:

- Associate of Arts in Professional Studies
- Bachelor of Science in Professional Studies
- Bachelor of Arts in Church Ministries

The offering of courses and/or programs via Distance Education is not included in the scope of approval for CCC.

After the staff review of your fall 2019 Institutional Response Matrix, CCC has satisfied 1 of the 3 Recommendations and all the Suggestions given by the Evaluation Team leaving 2 Recommendations "In Process". CCC is required to submit a Progress Report addressing the remaining "In Process" Recommendations by February 15, 2020, and must demonstrate compliance with these Recommendations by August 15, 2020.

When submitting your Progress Report matrix and supporting documentation, please send one printed copy and one electronic copy (on a CD or flash drive) of all materials. Be sure the electronic copy of the matrix is submitted in MS Word format. Progress Reports must be submitted in the requested format as TRACS will no longer accept Progress Reports by e-mail. The matrix will be provided to you in MS Word format as an e-mail attachment within the next few weeks.

Initial accreditation is for a period of five years (2019-2024). For Reaffirmation I, CCC must satisfy the remaining "In Process" Recommendations on your current matrix, complete a successful Self-Study, host an Evaluation Team, respond to any Findings, Recommendations, and Suggestions given by the Evaluation Team, and appear before the Accreditation Commission by fall of 2024.

When your status is printed in institutional publications or posted on your website, it must be stated accurately and fully in the following manner:

The Accredited Status is retroactive to the first day of the 2019 fall term or semester for CCC.
